**NW3C STAFF AND SPEAKERS SERVE AS EXPERTS FOR
UPCOMING EPISODE OF "AMERICA'S MOST WANTED"**

Richmond, VA National White Collar Crime Center (NW3C) staff and speakers will serve as experts when the popular crime-fighting show "America's Most Wanted" broadcasts a segment on extortion e-mail scams.

Among those interviewed were NW3C Board Chairman Glen Gainer, featured speaker Lt. Charles Cohen of the Indiana State Police, IC3 manager Greg Donewar and computer crimes specialist Nicholas Newman. The scam has been getting a lot of traction in the media because in most cases, the intended victim is threatened with murder unless he or she agrees to pay a substantial sum of money to the would-be killer.

Filming for the episode took place during the NW3C'S Global Conference on Economic and Hi-Tech Crime in Arlington, VA late last month. The AMW crew spent several hours on site, collecting information and conducting interviews.

A broadcast date for the program has not yet been determined.
